

Indoor Water Park and Lap Pool Guidelines

- A child 11 years old or younger must be supervised by an adult (18+) within the pool area.
- Do not enter the pool if you suspect you have communicable disease or open cuts or blisters.
- No street shoes on the pool deck.
- Must wear clean and family appropriate swimming attire.
- Children in diapers must wear reusable plastic pants or swim diapers with a snug elastic waist and legs.
- Diaper changing on the pool deck is prohibited, use the locker room.
- Shower before entering the pool or after use of toilet facilities.
- No food, gum or glass containers on the pool deck. No tobacco use allowed.
- Animals in the pool area are prohibited.
- Must be 16 or older to use the steam room.
- No hanging or climbing on the basketball hoops, wall separators and fencing. Do not plug holes in the jet area or any water spouts.
- If a child is wearing a swim vest or a life jacket, they are not to be in the lap pool or the jet area unless there is an adult with them, the adult needs to be in the water and within grabbing distance (5 feet or less) of the child.
- Do not run or engage in rough play in the pool area or locker rooms.
- Floatation allowed

• Floatation not allowed (if you have to blow air into it they are not allowed) inflatable water wings (Pictures below) (not allowed at Lunda)







Slide

- When no lifeguard is present the slide is closed.
- NO life jackets or floatation devices allowed.
- No toys are not allowed on the slide
- The child must meet the height requirement (48 inches) to go down alone.
- An adult 18 or older is allowed to go down the slide with a child.
- No catching someone at the bottom of the slide.
- Must enter the water feet first at the bottom of the slide.
- Throwing things off the slide is prohibited.
- Goggles are allowed on the slide.

Classes

- Must sign up and pay for the class prior to partaking.
- Classes are first come first serve.
- Only class participants are permitted in the water while a class is in session. No one can enter the water until class is completed which is when the instructor says they are complete.
- Participants of a class must join in the class activities, and cannot do their own thing in a different area of the pool.
